

BETTER PLACE LIQUIDATORS PUBLISH TENDER FOR SALE OF COMPANY ASSETS

Also for sale the right to import electric vehicles such as Renault Fluence and the lease agreement for offices in Rosh Ha'ayin

After more than two weeks of preparations, Better Place liquidators today (Monday) published the tender for sale of the company or its assets. The company is offered for sale in its entirety, but bids may also be submitted for purchase of certain portions. The portions for sale are the charging stations activity, the battery switching stations activity (four batteries required to be purchased with each station), the inventory of cars and batteries which can be purchased in whole or in part, the equipment located in the control rooms, and the server room located in the company's offices.

Also for sale the right to import electric vehicles such as Renault Fluence and others, and the lease agreement for the offices in Rosh Ha'ayin. Better Place intellectual property, including various patents, is offered separately and can be bought in whole or in part.

The liquidators, advocates Sigal Rosen-Rechev and Shaul Kotler, stated they are at liberty to negotiate bids, and that in any event bids providing for continued employment of the employees as well as continued operation of the charging infrastructure, including the battery swapping stations, shall be weighed favorably.
